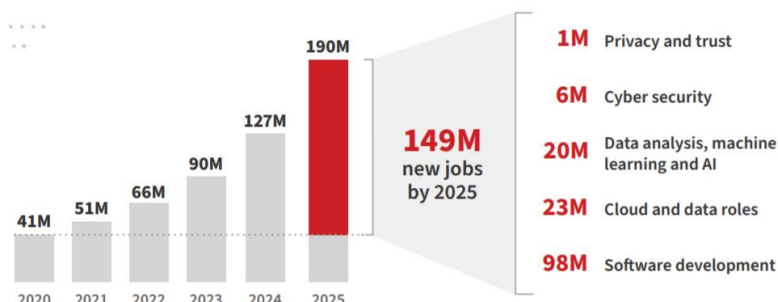

Are classes still running?
